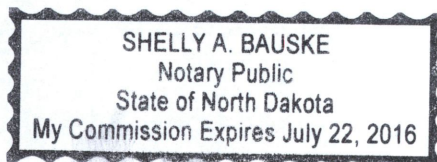

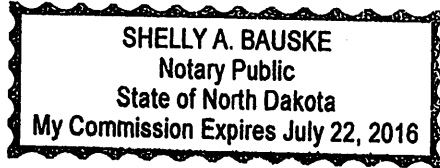


Submitted with the application was a statement by Crestwood Crude Logistics LLC that it desires electric service to be provided by the applicant. Service is to be provided at a point located in:
