- e. Notice of Intent to Obtain Coverage Under NDPDES General Permit for Stormwater Discharges Associated with Construction Activity, with accompanying NDPDES Permit No. NDR10-0000;
- f. McKenzie County Letter, dated August 19, 2015, confirming text amendment, zoning change, and conditional use permit for the Alexander Facility;
- g. McKenzie County Letter, dated November 19, 2015, confirming approval of zoning change and issuance of a conditional use permit for the NST Express pipeline and associated facilities;
- h. McKenzie County Approach Permit, dated February 24, 2015; and
- i. BNSF Railway Company Pipeline License, effective January 22, 2016.
