
This is to inform you that at the October 18, 2016 meeting, the McKenzie County Board of Commissioners approved the request for a conditional use permit to construct a pipeline interconnection via two (2) 10" lateral lines. The property is located in Section 1, Township 151N, Range 103W.

The following conditions are placed upon the Conditional Use Permit:

1. The applicant shall not deposit any snow or water onto neighboring properties and dispose of storm water onsite through an approved engineering method. Additionally, the applicant shall design the storm water and culvert system to convey a 25 year event.
2. The applicant shall adhere to noxious weed containment plan as submitted to the County Weed Control Officer.
3. The applicant shall maintain a site free of garbage, from within the site, or from outside sources, during construction and operation.
4. The applicant shall provide the County Planning Department with all State and Federal approvals, along with any violations relating to the project.
5. The applicant shall continually control dust and tracking during construction and operation on site to not track or create a nuisance to the neighboring property owners and the traveling public.
6. The applicant shall reseed the corridor with appropriate grass mixture to minimize erosion and

7. All above-ground facilities, such as pipe valve stations, stand pipes or electrical shall be painted earth tone colors.
8. This conditional use permit will remain in force, but can be terminated if there are violations or changes of the approved conditions. Any violation can cause this to be placed before the County Commission for revocation.
9. The applicant shall provide County GIS coordinator with shape files and as- built locations of all above or below ground equipment, pipelines and facilities within (60) sixty days of project being completed.
