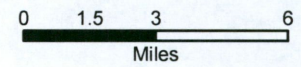

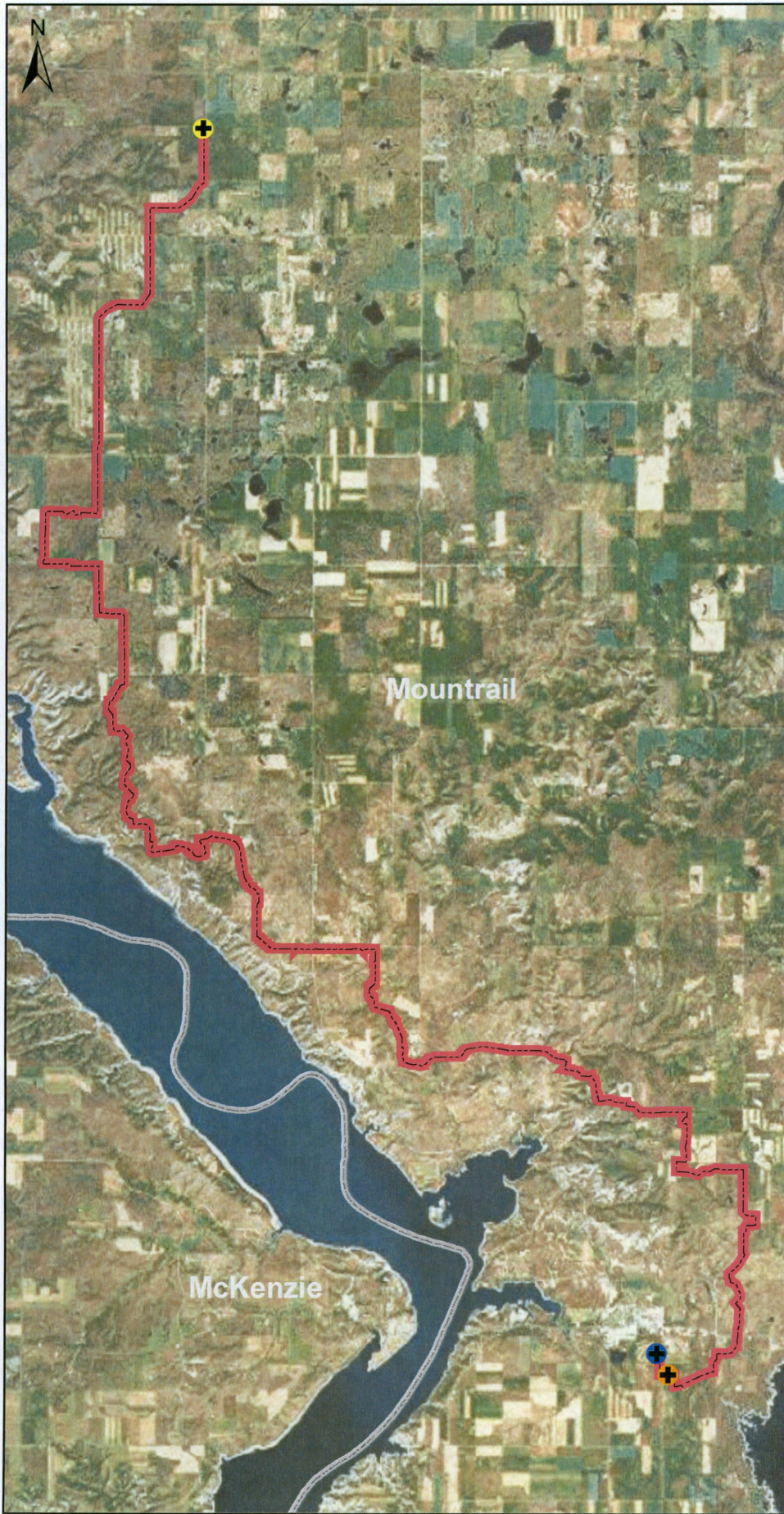
Overview Map New Town Expansion Project
