I'm Brian Hove, I live, farm and ranch in Lindahl Township. In regard of the Lindahl Wind Farm project, I believe the footprint in section 16-158-95 is already there. This section is a school section owned by the state and borders my home section 15. The school section already has 25 new wells drilled in the past couple years, 4 old wells with a central battery, roads going to wells, an electrical substation with two transmission lines, along with numerous old/new pipelines webbed through the section. I feel there is no more room to allow 6 wind turbines on this "Public Land". I would like to see these turbines moved to my neighbors land in sections 18 and 7 which is probably the highest ridge in the township. My neighbors have signed up for this project, I have not. In section 15 I have wet land easements signed with the Game and Fish that border the section lines. In the fall and winter when my trees lose there leaves I will be able to see these massive turbines from my kitchen table and by moving them to my neighbors land we will not be effected by any of the turbines projected at this time. And finally I ask for you to do a fly over or drive by the project area and look at section 16 158-95.
