Dear Mr. Nitschke:

On April 15, 2016, Lindahl Wind Project, LLC ("Lindahl Wind"), submitted a letter and documentation to the North Dakota Public Service Commission ("Commission") informing the Commission of minor modifications to the Lindahl Wind Farm Project ("Project") layout as a result of final micro-siting. As set forth in that letter, while all of the layout modifications are within areas previously field surveyed for cultural resources and wetlands (and covered by previously filed reports and State Historical Society of North Dakota ("SHSND") concurrences), Lindahl Wind was completing additional field survey work for areas that will or may potentially be needed for temporary construction workspace. That field survey work, and the associated reports, have now been completed.

Therefore, pursuant Order Provision Nos. 5 and 6 of the Commission's December 2, 2015 Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order in the above-referenced matter, the following documents are enclosed for filing:

1. A Class III Cultural Resources Inventory Report for Additional Areas, dated April 2016 [**NOTE: Not For Public Dissemination**];
2. A May 13, 2016 Concurrence Letter from the SHSND; and
3. An Updated Wetlands and Waters Survey Technical Memorandum, dated April 27, 2016.

An original and four copies of each of the above-referenced documents and this letter are enclosed. Also enclosed is a CD containing electronic copies of the enclosed public documents, and a separate CD marked "Not For Public Dissemination" containing an electronic copy of the Class III Cultural Resources Inventory Report.
