Dear Mr. Nitschke:

On December 2, 2015, the North Dakota Public Service Commission ("Commission") issued Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order ("Order") issuing a Certificate of Site Compatibility for the Lindahl Wind Farm Project ("Project"). Lindahl Wind Project, LLC ("Lindahl Wind"), filed an engineering design drawing on April 15, 2016, and an updated engineer design drawing (depicting certain layout modifications) on July 11, 2016. Since the July filing, Lindahl Wind has determined that additional minor modifications to the Project layout are necessary. Therefore, in accordance with Certification Provision No. 32 of the Order, Lindahl Wind provides this letter to inform the Commission of the planned modifications.

Enclosed is an updated engineering design drawing that identifies the modifications. A summary of each of the planned modifications follows:

1. Sections 9 & 16, T158N, R95W: In the engineering design drawing filed on July 11, 2016, Turbine F-5 was identified as a primary turbine location, and Turbine G-5 was identified as an alternate turbine location. During construction, Lindahl Wind discovered two abandoned wells and an associated waste pit near Turbine F-5. As a result, Lindahl Wind has decided to abandon Turbine F-5, and will make Turbine G-5 a primary turbine location.
2. Section 20, T158N, R95W and Sections 21 & 29, T159N, R95W: Fiber optic lines have been added to connect the three permanent meteorological towers to the nearest turbine.

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All of the layout modifications are within areas previously field surveyed for cultural resources and wetlands (and covered by previously filed reports and State Historical Society of North Dakota concurrences), and no exclusion or avoidance areas will be impacted.

An original and four copies of the updated engineering design drawing, as well as four copies of this letter, are enclosed. Electronic copies of the updated engineering design drawing and this letter were filed today with the Commission via e-mail.
