Dear Mr. Fahn:

Lindahl Wind Project, LLC (“Lindahl Wind”) received your letter, dated January 14, 2022, regarding the Reclamation Inspection Report prepared by the North Dakota Public Service Commission’s third-party inspector, filed November 2, 2018. As outlined below, all of the reclamation items identified in that report have been completed.

- 1. Stripping the topsoil at the laydown yard and decompaction of the subsoil to improve crop growth and yield across the area.*

In the summer of 2019, Lindahl Wind’s contractor removed the topsoil, decompacted the subsoil, and then re-spread the topsoil at the laydown yard.

- 2. A vegetation burn followed by re-seeding on State School Trust property (NW/4 of Section 36, T159N, R94W).*

In the fall of 2019, Lindahl Wind’s contractor performed the chemical burn on the State School Trust property. The area was then reseeded using a native seed mix approved and provided by the North Dakota State Land Department. New growth was established in the spring of 2020, and Lindahl Wind did not identify any bare areas or other areas needing additional seeding.


- 3. Completion of earthwork and re-seeding at two locations near Turbines B4 and B3.*

In the spring of 2020, Lindahl Wind’s contractor finished the earthwork and reseeded that was needed in the areas around Turbines B04 and B03.
