RE: Discontinue Business
Dakota Quality Grain Cooperative
Grain Warehouses – Parshall, Ross & New Town, ND

The Commission received a Request to Discontinue Business from Dakota Quality Grain Cooperative of Parshall, North Dakota for its licensed grain warehouses at Parshall, Ross and New Town, North Dakota. Dakota Quality Grain Cooperative asked the Commission to approve the request effective April 1, 2016.

Dakota Quality Grain Cooperative notified the Commission it is merging with United Prairie Cooperative into United Quality Cooperative. United Prairie Cooperative operates C-stores and bulk fuel deliveries in the Parshall, Ross and New Town areas. United Quality Cooperative is assuming all of Dakota Quality Grain Cooperative's outstanding grain, grain checks, and credit-sales contracts. United Quality Cooperative filed license applications for these facilities.

Staff recommends the request to discontinue business be approved effective April 1, 2016. A corresponding motion and order are attached.
