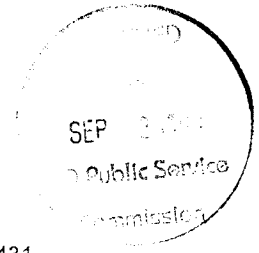

Seller hereby agrees to sell to: Farmers Elevator (hereafter called "Buyer")
the above grain which has been delivered to Farmers Elevator, Linton, ND

Title to the grain shall pass to Buyer at the time of delivery even though no price has been determined.

The grain delivered shall be listed in the assembly sheet summary below.

The purchase price of the grain is agreed to be Buyer's bid price, less charges, at the time Seller gives notice to Buyer to set the price. In the event Seller gives such notice after the trading hours of the Chicago Board of Trade and the Minneapolis Grain Exchange (presently 9:30 A.M. to 1:15 P.M., central time, Monday through Friday), Buyer reserves the right to defer setting a bid price until the next marked trading session.

In the event such notice shall have not been given on or before **May 12, 2016** the price of the grain shall be Buyer's bid price, less charges, after the close of the market on said date.

Seller shall pay Buyer a service charge equal to the greater of **6.000 cents per bu or 6.000 cents per bu per month or fraction thereof** from the date of dates of delivery of the grain to the date of such notice (which is the date that the price is set). Both the service charge and the purchase price shall be payable within ten days from the date that the price is set.

WARRANTY. Seller warrants that he has title to and the right to sell the above described commodity, that the same is free and clear of all liens, security interests and encumbrances and hereby agrees to warrant and defend the title hereto against all claims.
