Description (summarize the observations on which you rely to allege the violation) <i>If more space is required, please provide the description on a separate page.</i>  On or about 7/13/2015 at 19:30 Carstensen Contracting Inc. was trenching for a new 2" water line without a One Call when they encounter a 12" steel natural gas pipeline owned by Oneok Rockies Midstream, LLC. According to local land owner they encountered the pipeline around 19:30 and then shut down and moved all equipment from the location. At 23:44 on 7/13/2015 the company submitted a request for a locate request for this area. At no time did they contact Oneok to let us know they hit our pipeline. It was our contract locating company that notified us on 7/14/2015 when they responded to the locate request and found that the contractor had already crossed our pipeline and that there was damage to our pipeline. Brief Description of Pipeline Incident: Carstensen Contracting Inc. was working for WAESA at the location of 6450 133<sup>rd</sup> Ave W which is ½ mile north on 133<sup>rd</sup> and from the north side of Hwy 2 east. Jose Cervantes of Carstensen was digging to install a 2" water line to the residence with NO one-call called in to 811 call center system. Later that night on the 13th at 11:44 pm the contractor call 811 to get a one-call started on the line that was hit. Our locators called me about the ticket because it was already dug up in the area of our line and they notice that the line was damaged. Once I arrived on site I called Jason to start the repair process, the line is being blown down now on July 14 starting at 4:00 with 750# on it and distance of 5 miles. S K & S has been called to repair the line on July 15 at 8:00 am after blow down is complete.
