



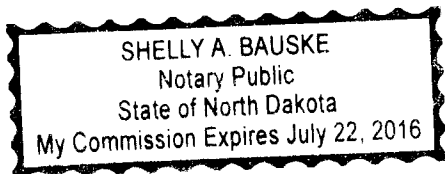

Technology Crops LLC dba Technology Crops International of Winston-Salem, North Carolina operates as a roving grain buyer under license number 3180 issued by the Public Service Commission under the provisions of North Dakota Century Code Chapter 60-02.1.
