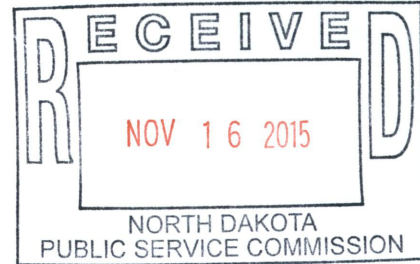

COMPANY INFORMATION

At the October 29, 2015 public hearing for the Certificate of Corridor Compatibility and Route Permit Application submitted by Plains Pipeline, L.P. ("Plains") for the Highway 1804 Re-Route North Pipeline Project ("Project"), the North Dakota Public Service Commission ("Commission") requested that Plains provide certain clarifying information regarding the company. Specifically, the Commission requested that Plains provide information regarding the company structure of Plains, the number of employees in North Dakota, and the location of the nearest Plains employees in the event of an emergency. As requested, Plains provides the following information:

1. Plains All American Pipeline, L.P. ("PAA") is a publicly traded limited partnership formed in Delaware in 1998. PAA's operations are conducted directly and indirectly through its primary operating subsidiaries. PAA owns and operates midstream energy infrastructure and provides logistics services for crude oil, natural gas liquids ("NGL"), natural gas, and refined products. PAA owns an extensive network of pipeline transportation, terminalling, storage, and gathering assets in key crude oil and NGL producing basins and transportation corridors, and at major market hubs in the United States and Canada.
2. Plains Pipeline, L.P. ("Plains") is a Texas limited partnership formed in 1998 with its principal place of business at 333 Clay Street, Suite 1600, Houston, Texas, 77002. Plains is an operating subsidiary of PAA.
3. Plains has twenty-four (24) employees in North Dakota and thirteen (13) employees in eastern Montana.
4. Plains has two (2) employees located in Watford City, North Dakota, and twelve (12) employees located in Sidney, Montana. These fourteen (14) employees, located in close proximity to the Project, would respond in case of an emergency involving the Project.
