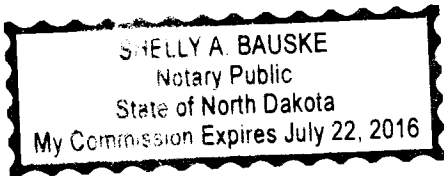

ORDER GRANTING REQUEST
TO DISCONTINUE BUSINESS

September 16, 2015

Harlow Coop Elevator & Seed Company operates licensed public grain warehouses at Harlow, Minnewaukan, and Maddock North Dakota, under license numbers 541, 543, and 706, respectively issued by the Public Service Commission under the provisions of North Dakota Century Code Chapter 60-02. The Commission received a request to discontinue business for these facilities.

Order


The Commission orders:

1. Warehouse license numbers 541, 543, and 706, respectively issued to Harlow Coop Elevator & Seed Company are cancelled and Harlow Coop Elevator & Seed Company shall remit license numbers 541, 543, and 706 to the Commission; and
