AFFIDAVIT RELATING TO SITE MODIFICATIONS

The undersigned, Melissa Hochmuth, Project Manager, a representative of Brady Wind, LLC (“Brady Wind”) with authority to bind Brady Wind to the following, hereby certifies as follows:

1. In an order dated June 16, 2016, in the above captioned matter, the Public Service Commission (“Commission”) approved the Certificate of Site Compatibility No. 48 for the construction, operation and maintenance of a wind energy conversion facility in Stark County.
2. Pursuant to Paragraph 34 of the Certification Relating to Order Provisions associated with the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order issued on June 16, 2016 (“Order”), Brady Wind files the following Affidavit Relating to Site Modification to inform the Commission of its plan to modify the wind energy conversion facility.
3. Brady Wind intends to make the following minor modifications to the site plan as reflected in the attached map.
4. Meteorological (MET) tower ALTSM01 was activated. This MET tower relates to the site plan filed with the Commission on June 17, 2016 in this proceeding. This tower location was previously surveyed but associated guy wire locations were not. The modifications contained in this Affidavit relate to the previously un-surveyed guy wire locations.
5. Pursuant to Order provision No. 4, Brady Wind completed a Class III cultural resource survey on the previously un-surveyed land and no archeological resources were found. Brady Wind submitted the cultural resource findings to the State Historical Society of North Dakota (NDSHPO) for review. Brady Wind will file NDSHPO’s response regarding this survey once it is received.
6. In accordance with the Certification Relating to Order Provisions and Order, Brady Wind certifies as follows:

- a. Construction activities have been, and will continue to be, conducted wholly within the site as designated in the Order. All necessary right-of-way easements within the specified site have been acquired.
 - b. As demonstrated previously in this case, an environmental analysis was conducted for Brady Wind and evaluated the wind energy conversion facility site relative to the Exclusion and Avoidance Areas set forth in N.D. Admin. Code § 69-06-08-01.
 - c. Negligible permanent impacts of three (3) square feet to Prime Farmland will result from the tower installation and use of two guy wires located in prime farmland.
 - d. No other Exclusion or Avoidance Areas will be permanently affected.
7. Brady Wind will continue to comply with the Order issued in this case designating the site, and will continue to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws and rules.




