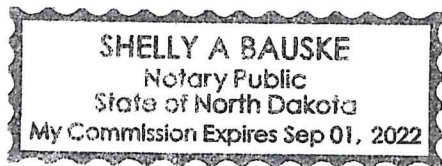

ORDER ON CERTIFICATE OF CORRIDOR COMPATIBILITY AND ROUTE PERMIT

May 4, 2022

Preliminary Statement

On August 17, 2016, the Commission adopted its Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order in Case No. PU-15-694 issuing Certificate of Corridor Compatibility No. 190 and Route Permit No. 202 to ONEOK Bakken Pipeline, L.L.C. (ONEOK) designating a location for the construction, operation, and maintenance of approximately 14.4 miles of 16-inch diameter natural gas liquids pipeline and associated facilities in McKenzie County, North Dakota.

On February 16, 2022, Commission Staff sent a letter to ONEOK requesting an update on the construction of the project.

On April 14, 2022, ONEOK emailed a response to Staff's February 16, 2022, request for information.

Discussion

The April 14, 2022, response from Todd McKimmey, Vice President of Integrated Operations and Capital Projects, ONEOK Bakken Pipeline, L.L.C., states that, as the project was never constructed and ONEOK has no plans to move forward with the project, ONEOK would like to relinquish Certificate of Corridor Compatibility No. 190 and Route Permit No. 202.

Based on the evidence enumerated above, the Commission finds that ONEOK's request to relinquish Certificate of Corridor Compatibility No. 190 and Route Permit No. 202 should be granted.

Order

ONEOK Bakken Pipeline, L.L.C.'s request to relinquish Certificate of Corridor Compatibility No. 190 and Route Permit No. 202 is granted.
