NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

On **October 20, 2015**, Otter Tail Power Company, an electric public utility, filed an application under Chapter 49-03, N.D.C.C. to extend service to Canadian Pacific Railroad at a location in Richland County, ND.

Submitted with the application was a statement by Canadian Pacific Railroad that it desires electric service to be provided by the applicant. Service is to be provided at a point located in:

The SW ¼, NW ¼ of Section 20, Twp 130N, R 48W, Richland County, North Dakota.

Otter Tail Power Company has made a prima facie showing that it should serve the customer.

Any interested party has the right to file written objection, based on the issue of public convenience and necessity, with the Commission by **November 30, 2015**, and the matter will then be set for hearing. If no objections are received by that date, the application may be granted as requested.
