At the time this notice is being prepared, the October 12, 2016 special meeting is for the purpose of attorney consultation in this litigation challenging the EPA rule, **Standards of Performance for Greenhouse Gas Emissions from New, Modified, and Reconstructed Stationary Sources Carbon Pollution Emission Guidelines**, in the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit, *State of North Dakota v. Environmental Protection Agency, et al.*, No. 15-1381 (and consolidated cases). This item may be discussed in an executive session. The legal authority for closing this portion of the meeting is North Dakota Century Code Chapter 44-04, including N.D.C.C. §§ 44-04-19.1 and 19.2.

In a closed meeting, the Commission's discussion will be limited to the topic and executive session described above.
