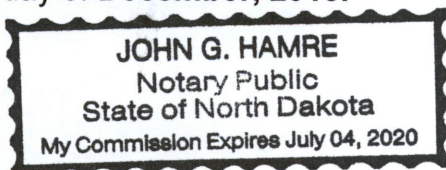

**NOTICE OF FILINGS AND NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING**

**December 21, 2015**

ONEOK Bakken Pipeline, L.L.C. (ONEOK) has filed applications to amend the corridor and route approved by the Commission in their December 2, 2011, Order in Case Number PU-11-66. ONEOK proposes to adjust the pipeline route outside of the approved corridor in Section 3 of Township 148 North, Range 102 West, of McKenzie County, as shown on the attached map (Case No. PU-15-725). The company has also filed an application for waivers of procedures and time schedules established under North Dakota Century Code sections 49-22-07.2, 49-22-08, 49-22-08.1, 49-22-13, and North Dakota Administrative Code section 69-06-01-02 and chapter 69-06-06, requiring separate filings, separate notices, separate hearings, and certain time schedules on such applications.

The issues to be considered in the application for waiver of procedures and time schedules are:

1. Are the proposed facilities of such length, design, location, or purpose that they will produce minimal adverse effects and that adherence to applicable procedures and time schedules may be waived?
2. Is it appropriate for the Commission to waive any procedures and time schedules as requested in the application?

The issues to be considered in the proposed amendments to the December 2, 2011, Order in Case Number PU-11-66 are:

1. Will the location and operation of the proposed facilities produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Are the proposed facilities compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will the proposed facility locations minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and

integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?



Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearing must be received by January 22, 2016.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.

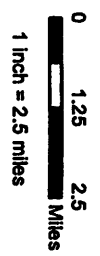
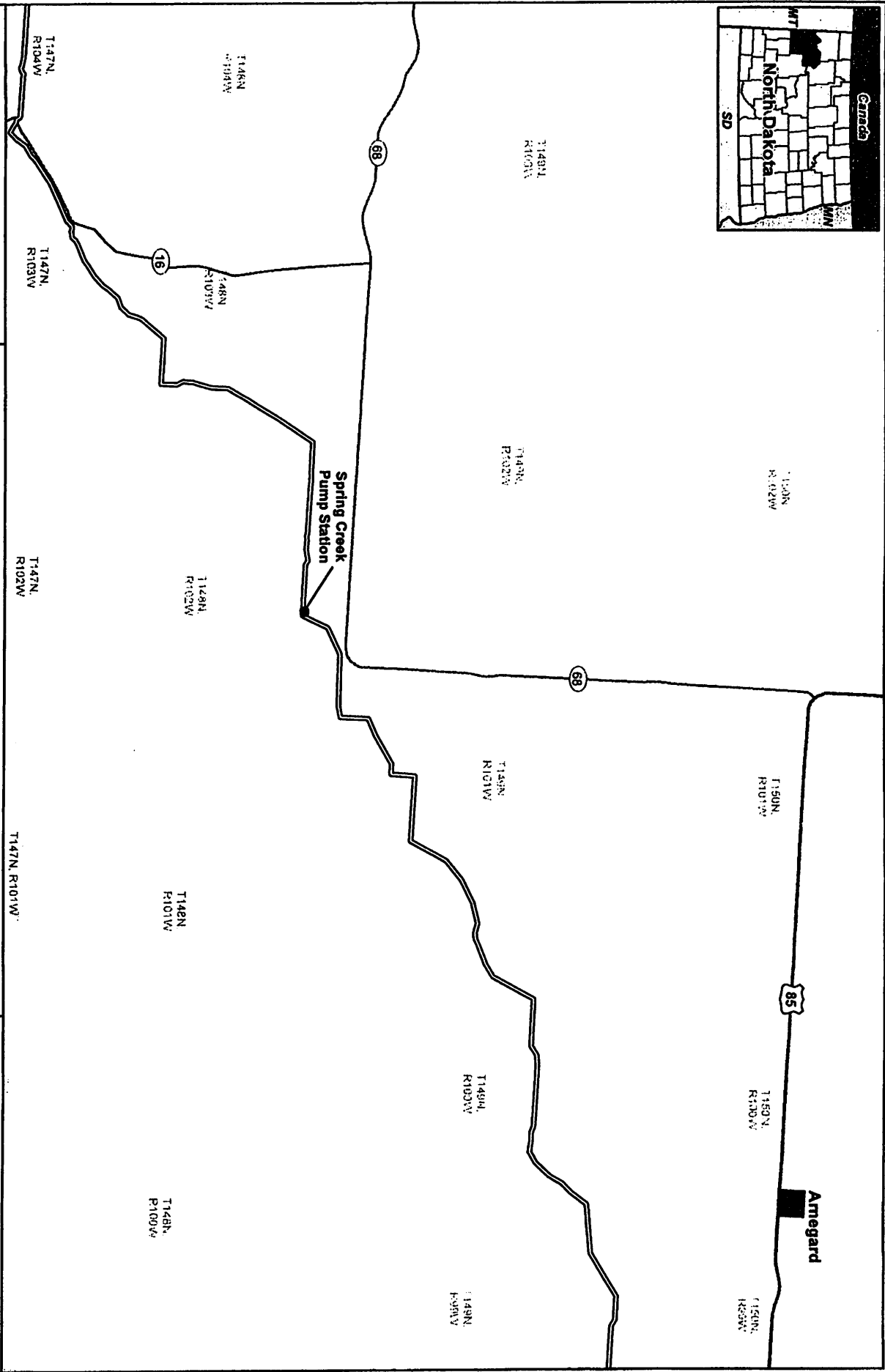
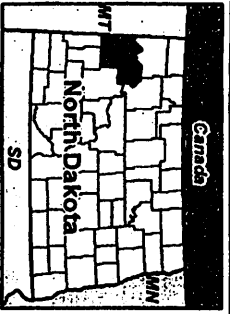
