The preconstruction discussion focused on Case No. PU-15-725, Spring Creek Pump Station Project – McKenzie County Siting Application, Order Amending Certificate and Permit dated February 10, 2016.

Julie Prescott read through the order noting the applicability of several items since this project is being constructed on ONEOK property.

During construction, representatives from Keitu Engineers & Consultants, Inc. plan to visit the site with prior notice and coordination. The need to observe topsoil segregation is not critical because the site is ONEOK property.
