Subject: WAWSA notification for PCS consolidated application	

McCarthy contacted Mr. Wirtz, Executive Director, Western Area Water Supply Authority (WAWSA) to provide project notification of the proposed Oasis Wild Basin to Johnsons Corner Pipeline. McCarthy advised Wirtz that the project is considered a transmission line and is therefore under the jurisdiction of the North Dakota Public Service Commission (Commission). Per siting requirements (i.e.; NDAC 69-06-08-02.2) project sponsors are required to evaluate potential impacts to water sources of organized rural water district(s).

McCarthy stated the purpose of the call and provided Wirtz with project background regarding location, diameter of proposed pipeline and overview of Commission jurisdiction. Wirtz confirmed that the WAWSA water source is from a treatment plant located in Williston which draws its water from the Missouri River and would not be impacted by the project.

In closing, Wirtz noted it was the WAWSA's preference that when crossing their water lines, that the crossings be done at 90° where practicable. Both parties agreed that the use of the North Dakota One Call system would facilitate the location of existing assets and would promote the opportunity to discuss site specific crossing details appropriately.
