Carlson McCain on behalf of Oasis Midstream Services LLC (Oasis) submitted a Tree and Shrub Monitoring Report for 2019 (Docket No. 80) to the North Dakota Public Service Commission (ND PSC) for the Wild Basin to Johnsons Corner Pipeline Project (Project, PU-15-733) on January 9, 2020. In accordance with the approved Tree and Shrub Mitigation Plan (Docket No. 72), Oasis has continued to coordinate with the McKenzie County Soil Conservation District (MCSCD) to plant and monitor the survival of trees and shrubs.

As reported in the approved Tree and Shrub Mitigation Plan, a total of 1,192 trees or shrubs were removed during the construction of the Project. Per the PSC's Tree and Shrub Mitigation Specifications, a minimum of 2,384 replacement plantings are required.

To date a total of 2,916 plantings have occurred, with a survival rate of approximately 76%. Oasis will continue to coordinate with the MCSCD to monitor the survival of plantings through 2021.
