



Carlson McCain on behalf of Oasis Midstream Services LLC (Oasis) has compiled and respectfully submits the following Tree and Shrub Mitigation Report. With this filing, Oasis has fulfilled all of the North Dakota Public Service Commission (Commission) obligations as stipulated by the Tree and Shrub Monitoring Plan (Plan) for the Wild Basin to Johnsons Corner Pipeline Project (Project, PU-15-733).

A summary of Oasis’ actions taken to satisfy the Plan’s planting/replacement requirements are detailed in the following table:

Table 1: Oasis Johnsons Corner Pipeline Tree and Shrub Plantings.

Trees and Shrubs Taken	Minimum Trees and Shrubs to be Planted	Actual Trees and Shrubs Planted
1,192	2,384	2,916

As stipulated by the Plan, a minimum survival rate of 75% at three years post-planting has been met. Please refer to the following table detailing survival requirements and observations.

As detailed in Table’s 1 and 2, Oasis has satisfied the minimum the number of plantings and has achieved a survival rate at three years post planting in excess of the required minimum rate of 75% (92% survival of base required plantings).

In summary, Oasis has complied and fulfilled the requirements of the Plan by meeting minimum planting requirements, conducting three years of post-planting survival monitoring, and achieving minimum survival rates of the plantings. As such, Oasis respectfully requests the termination of the Plan.
