## **Abstract**

Sacagawea Pipeline Company (the Proponent) has proposed a connector line for an oil pipeline in sections 13, 14 and 23 of T150N, R96W of McKenzie County, North Dakota. Due to the involvement of a state agency (ND Public Service Commission (ND PSC)), Keitu Engineers and Consultants on behalf of the proponent has hired Beaver Creek Archaeology, Inc. (BCA) to conduct a file search and complete a Class I Cultural Resource Inventory report. This report reflects the environmental setting, cultural history, and file search results of the project's proposed location.

The file search revealed eight sites and twelve isolated finds within a one-mile radius of the proposed project area. None of the previously recorded cultural resources are located within the 9,200 foot long 150 foot wide Area of Potential Effect (APE) and will not be impacted by this proposed project. Portions of the APE have been previously inventoried at Class III levels. However, approximately 5,750 feet of the APE has not been surveyed for cultural resources. Due to the number of previously recorded sites and isolated finds in the vicinity, BCA recommends a Class III for those portions not previously surveyed at a Class III level.
