Sacagawea Pipeline Company, LLC (“Sacagawea”) submitted a Certificate of Corridor Compatibility Application and Route Permit Application, requesting permission from the North Dakota Public Service Commission (“Commission”) for the proposed construction of a crude oil pipeline approximately 13 miles in length located in McKenzie County, North Dakota on November 20, 2015 (PU-15-744). Since the original submittal, Sacagawea has identified the need for an additional pipeline segment that would originate from Johnson’s Corner, North Dakota and terminate at an interconnection with Dakota Access Pipeline (“DAPL”). Sacagawea has prepared an Amended Application to address this additional segment known as “JC to DAPL”. This additional segment is approximately 2 miles in length.

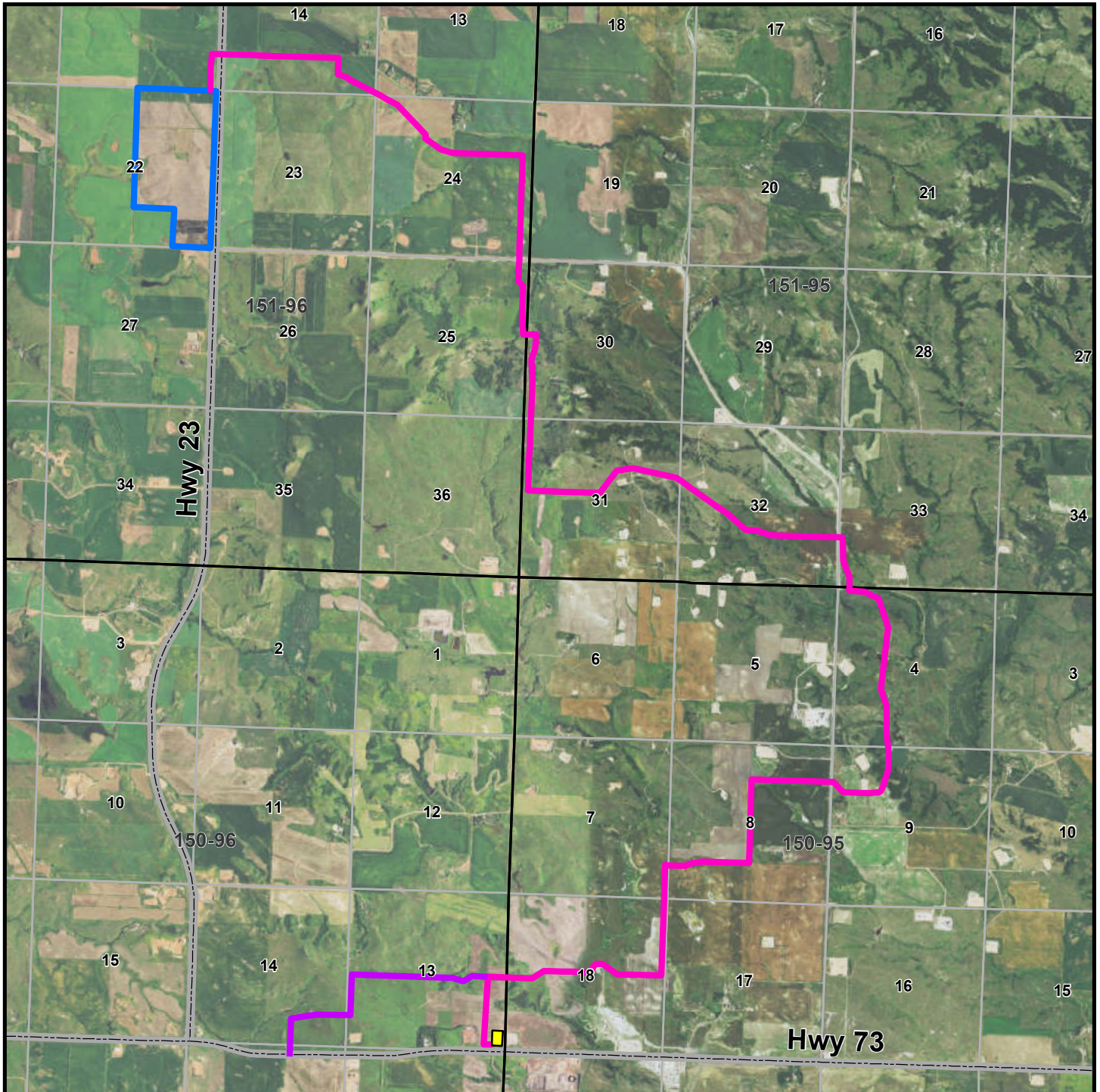
Keitu Engineers and Consultants, Inc. (“Keitu”) is contracted by Sacagawea to submit the Amendment for Certificate of Corridor Compatibility and Route Application in February 2016. The Commission requires applicants to contact relevant agencies for comment on the Project.

This is in response to your request for review of environmental impacts associated with the Sacagawea Pipeline Company's, LLC, Johnson's Corner Connector Pipeline project. The original project proposal was to be 13 miles in length located in McKenzie County, ND. The amended project proposal will be additional segment known as "JC to DAPL" that is approximately 2 miles in length.

The proposed project has been reviewed by State Water Commission staff and the following comments are provided:

- There are no floodplains identified and/or mapped where this proposed project is to take place. The project takes place in a No Special Flood Hazard Area. No floodplain permits are necessary from McKenzie County relative to the National Flood Insurance Program.
- It is the responsibility of the project sponsor to ensure that local, state and federal agencies are contacted for any required approvals, permits, and easements.
- All waste material associated with the project must be disposed of properly and not placed in identified floodway areas.
