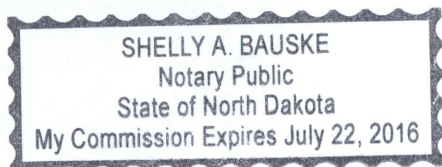

NOTICE OF CONTINUED HEARINGS

February 25, 2016

The **public hearing** on the application in Case No. PU-15-690 that was previously scheduled for March 2, 2016, is **continued to March 30, 2016 at 8:00 a.m. Mountain Time**, at City Hall, 99 2nd Street East, Dickinson, North Dakota 58601.

The **public hearing** on the applications in Case No. PU-15-797 that was previously scheduled for March 2, 2016, is **continued to March 30, 2016 at 5:00 p.m. Mountain Time**, at City Hall, 99 2nd Street East, Dickinson, North Dakota 58601.

Brady Wind, LLC filed an application for a Certificate of Site Compatibility concerning the location of a 150 MW Brady Wind Energy Center consisting of up to 87 wind turbine generators and associated facilities in Stark County, North Dakota, as shown on the attached map, Case No. PU-15-690.

Brady Wind, LLC filed applications for a certificate of corridor compatibility and a route permit concerning the location for approximately 19 miles of 230 kV electric transmission line and associated facilities in Stark County, North Dakota, as shown on the attached map, Case No. PU-15-797.

Also in Case No. PU-15-797, Brady Wind, LLC filed an application for waivers of procedures and time schedules established under North Dakota Century Code sections 49-22-07.2, 49-22-08, 49-22-08.1, 49-22-13, and North Dakota Administrative Code section 69-06-01-02 and chapter 69-06-06, requiring separate filings, separate notices, and separate hearings on corridor and route applications.

The issues to be considered in the application for waiver of procedures and time schedules in Case No. PU-15-797 are:

1. Are the proposed facilities of such length, design, location, or purpose that they will produce minimal adverse effects and that adherence to applicable procedures and time schedules may be waived?

2. Is it appropriate for the Commission to waive any procedures and time schedules as requested in the application?

The issues to be considered in the application for certificate of site compatibility in Case No. PU-15-690 and the applications for certificate of corridor compatibility and route permit in Case No. PU-15-797 are:


1. Will the location and operation of the proposed facilities produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Are the proposed facilities compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will the proposed facility locations minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?

If it finds that a waiver of procedures and time schedules is appropriate, the Commission may proceed to consider the application for a corridor certificate and route permit without further notice.

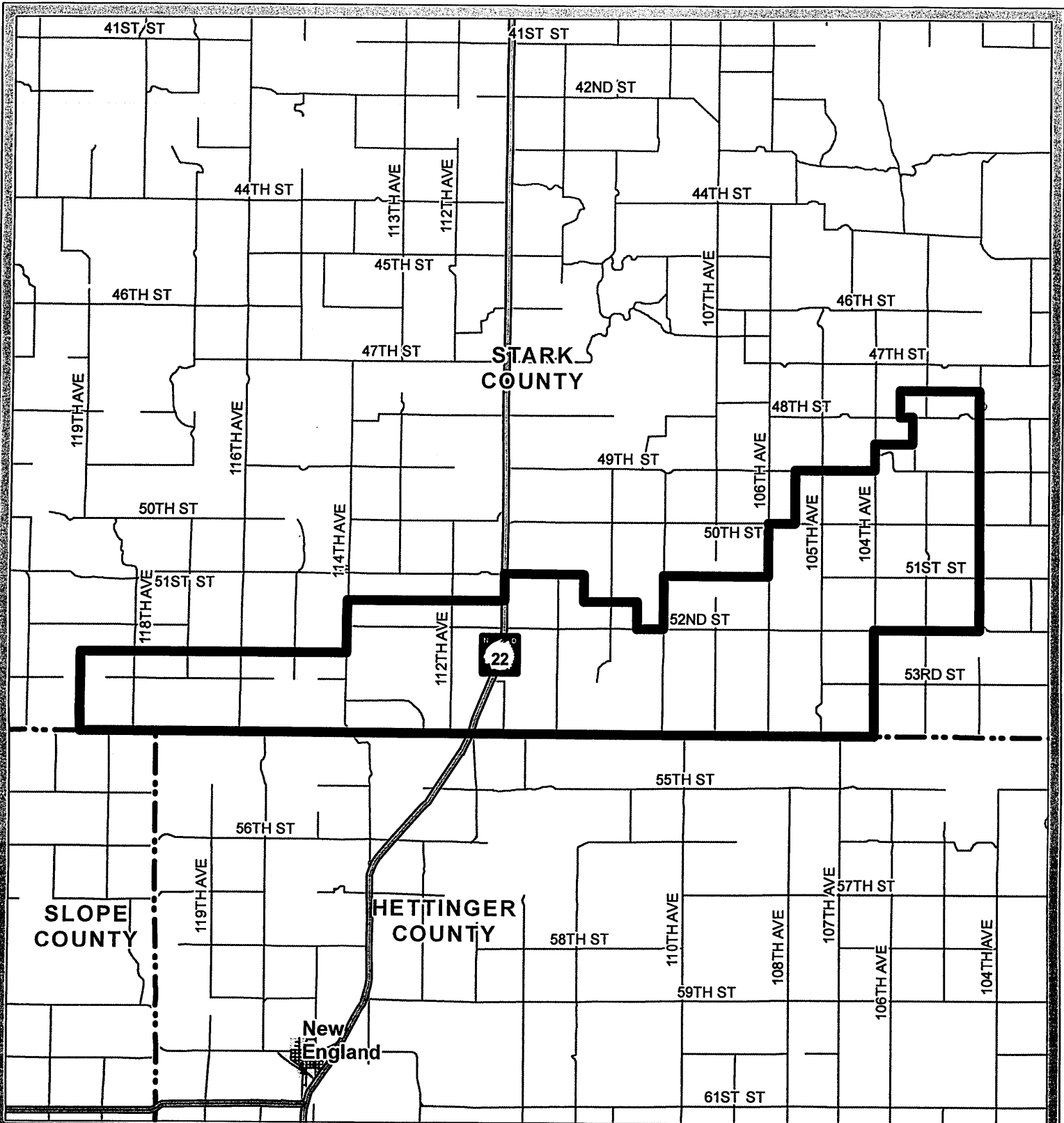

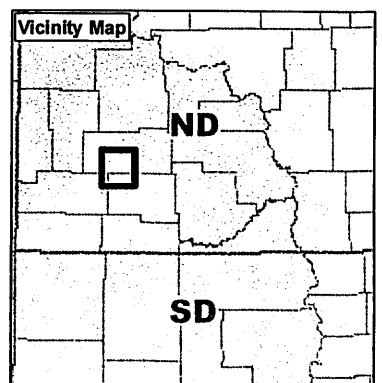
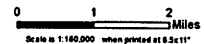
