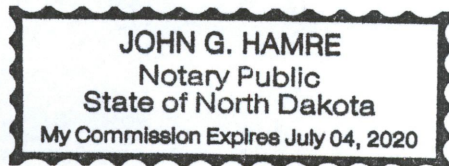





NOTICE OF FILINGS AND PUBLIC HEARING

January 20, 2016

A public hearing on the applications in Case No. PU-15-801 is scheduled for **February 22, 2016, at 9:00 a.m. MST (10:00 a.m. CST) at the Killdeer City Hall, 165 Railroad Street SE, Killdeer, ND 58640.**

ONEOK Bakken Pipeline, L.L.C. (ONEOK) has filed applications for a certificate of corridor compatibility and a route permit for an 8-inch outside diameter natural gas liquid (NGL) pipeline totaling approximately 38 miles in length. The pipeline will originate at the ONEOK Rockies Midstream, L.L.C. Bear Creek Plant in Dunn County, North Dakota and extend to the northwest to terminate at an interconnect with ONEOK's existing Targa Pipeline in McKenzie County, North Dakota, as shown on the attached map. The Bear Creek Plant is under construction and is anticipated to be complete in September 2016. The Company is looking at two points for the interconnection with the Targa pipeline depending on landowner negotiations. The preferred interconnection is at a receiver site at ONEOK's Targa Lateral Pipeline approximately 8 miles south of Watford City. The alternative tie-in is at the Targa Gas Plant, which is not an ONEOK facility, and result in the line being approximately 37 miles in length. The line will carry NGL from the Bear Creek Plant to the Targa NGL pipeline, then onto other pipelines for delivery to facilities in the Mid-Continent and Gulf Coast for additional processing.

ONEOK has also filed an application for waivers of procedures and time schedules established under North Dakota Century Code sections 49-22-07.2, 49-22-08, 49-22-08.1, 49-22-13, and North Dakota Administrative Code sections 69-06-01-02, 69-06-05-01 and 69-06-06 requiring separate filings, separate notices, separate hearings, certain time schedules and a specific width on the certificate of corridor compatibility and route permit applications.

On January 20, 2016, the Commission deemed complete the applications for a certificate of corridor compatibility and for a route permit.

The issues to be considered in the application for waiver of procedures and time schedules are:


1. Are the proposed facilities of such length, design, location, or purpose that they will produce minimal adverse effects and that adherence to applicable procedures and time schedules may be waived?
2. Is it appropriate for the Commission to waive any procedures and time schedules as requested in the application?

The issues to be considered in the applications for a certificate of corridor compatibility and a route permit are:

1. Will the location and operation of the proposed facilities produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Are the proposed facilities compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will the proposed facility locations minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?
