We have received the ONEOK February 16th letter correspondence with respect to the aforementioned project and thank you for the in-person meeting on February 10th regarding it. As outlined, we concur with a "No significant sites affected" determination for the ONEOK Bakken Pipeline LLC, Bear Creek NGL project except for the eight (8) specific site locations listed and discussed in the February 16th letter that we find acceptable, provided the project is of the nature stated and that it takes place in the location mapped and plotted in the overall documentation.

Thank you for the opportunity to review the forthcoming testing and evaluation plan for seven (7) sites: 32DU99, 32MZ487, 32DU2289, 32DU2290, 32DU2292, 32DU2295, and 32DU2299, and we look forward to further consultation on the mitigation plan for the eighth site (32DU2216) for the ONEOK Bakken Pipeline LLC, Bear Creek NGL project.
