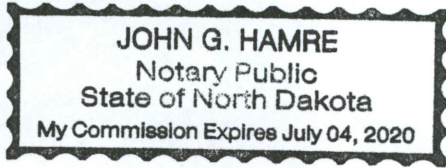

January 20, 2016


On December 31, 2015, Otter Tail Power Company (Otter Tail) filed a request for approval of its 2016 Renewable Resource Cost Recovery Adjustment Factor for recovering costs associated with its electric generation wind farms, effective April 1, 2016. The proposed change would increase the average monthly cost of service \$1.08 cents for customers using 1,000 kWh.

The issue to be considered is whether the proposed cost recovery is fair and reasonable.

Comments and requests for a hearing must be received by **March 1, 2016**. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. If deemed appropriate, the commission can determine these matters without a hearing.
