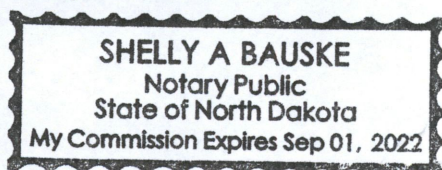

December 14, 2016


On November 21, 2016, Northern States Power Company (NSP) filed with the Commission a petition to refund \$1,013,041 received by NSP pursuant to a settlement with the United States regarding the Department of Energy's partial breach of contract to take spent nuclear fuel.

The issue is to determine whether the proposed refund is just and reasonable.

Comments and requests for a hearing must be received by **January 30, 2017**. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. If deemed appropriate, the commission can determine these matters without a hearing.
