On July 6, 2016, the North Dakota Public Service Commission ("Commission") issued an order in Case No. PU-16-042 approving the construction of the wind facility proposed by Brady Wind II, LLC ("Brady Wind II"). Paragraph 39 of the Commission's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order requires that Brady II advise the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service ("USFWS") that sworn testimony was received at the Commission hearing in this case about the potential presence of prairie dog towns in Hettinger County at Township 136, Range 97, Section 8, SE; and in Stark County at Township 137, Range 95, Section 9, SE. 

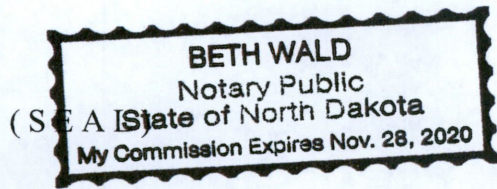
