**NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND ORDER AND
NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING**

October 2, 2019

On May 5, 2016, the Commission issued its Order on Eligible Telecommunications Carrier Designation (Order) in case PU-16-48 designating Midcontinent Communications (Midco) as an eligible telecommunications carrier in 29 exchange areas within North Dakota.

On March 29, 2017, the Commission issued its Order on Eligible Telecommunications Carrier Designation (Order) in case PU-17-50 designating Midco as an eligible telecommunications carrier in the Cooperstown exchange area within North Dakota.

On September 6, 2019 Midco filed a Motion to Partially Amend Orders, requesting that the commission eliminate the requirements contained within Order point 2 in cases PU-16-48 and PU-17-50.


The issue is whether the Orders should be amended to remove the requirement to file annually a complete listing of lifeline customers including the type of proof reviewed, eligibility dates, and North Dakota Department of Human Services Form SFN 1059.

Comments and requests for hearing must be received by November 18, 2019. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.


