The Brady Wind Energy Center ("Brady Wind") is a proposed wind project located in Stark County, North Dakota. As proposed, the project will have a nameplate capacity of approximately 150 megawatts (MW) consisting of up to 87 wind turbines using both 80 General Electric (GE) 1.715 MW wind turbine generators and 7 GE 1.79 MW wind turbine generators. Additional facilities will include access roads, electrical collection systems and cabling, a collection substation, an operation and maintenance (O&M) building, meteorological towers, a construction laydown area, and a temporary turbine storage area.

Construction is scheduled to begin in April 2016, and commercial operation is scheduled for October 2016. The project is not expected to retire in the next ten years.

The Brady Wind Energy Center includes an electrical collection system that transports energy from the 87 turbine feeders to the wind project collector substation. The Brady Wind Energy Center interconnects with the 230kV transmission line owned by Basin Electric Power Cooperative via an approximately 19 mile generation tie-line. Construction of the generation tie-line is scheduled to begin in April 2016, and commercial operation is scheduled for October 2016. The project is not expected to retire in the next ten years.



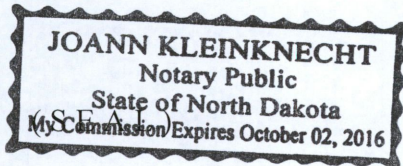
