

On August 26, 2016, a compliance letter was sent to Derek Thompson, T & T Measurements, Inc. regarding the inspections taken place at Farmers Union Oil, Warwick and Erling Oil Co., Osnabrock.

The retail fuel dispensers were left in tolerance; however, the dispensers were left with an error predominantly in favor of the operator which is a violation of NIST Handbook 44 (1999 Edition) G-UR.4.1.

A memo was sent to the liquid registered service companies on September 14, 2016 informing them NIST Handbook 44 (1999 Edition) G-UR.4.1 will be enforced.

Since the compliance letter to T & T Measurements, Inc. was sent prior to the directive, upon further review and visiting with Travis Thompson, the owner of T & T Measurements, Inc., and the hardship this would cause the operator, the requirement to return to the location to recalibrate and certify the retail fuel dispensers has been waived.
