RE: Warehouse License
United Quality Cooperative – Parshall, Ross and New Town

United Quality Cooperative of Parshall, North Dakota, filed license applications to operate a 2,961,000 bushel grain warehouse at Parshall, North Dakota, an 1,414,000 bushel grain warehouse at New Town, and a 2,590,000 bushel grain warehouse Ross, North Dakota. The combined capacity is 6,965,000 bushels. United Quality Cooperative filed a corresponding \$2 million bond. This bond amount reflects the required 30% additional bond coverage for a new licensee.

United Quality Cooperative asked the Commission to approve the license applications effective April 1, 2016. United Quality Cooperative will assume all Dakota Quality Grain Cooperative outstanding grain, grain checks, and credit-sale contracts. United Quality Cooperative notified the Commission it has not operated as a grain warehouseman in North Dakota.

Statutory compliance has been met and Staff recommends the request be approved. A corresponding motion and order are attached.
