Additional facilities will include access roads, electrical collection systems and cabling, a collection substation, an operation and maintenance building, meteorological towers, and a construction laydown area.

Construction is scheduled to begin in July of 2016, and commercial operation is scheduled for December 2016. The project is not expected to retire in the next ten years.



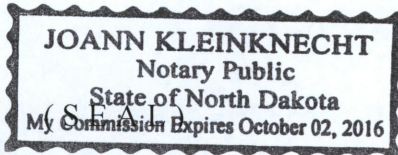
