Hi Rikki,

Attached is the draft federal grant application containing Standard Form 424 for the Public Service Commission's 2017 Administration and Enforcement Grant Application that we plan to submit next week to the federal Office of Surface Mining (OSM) within the Department of the Interior. The PSC will be requesting \$967,972 in federal funds for the next one year grant period that begins July 1, 2016. The total costs to continue to administer and enforce North Dakota's coal regulatory program for the one-year grant period are estimated to be \$1,512,456 and those costs are split between federal funds and state general funds. The federal share is 64% of the total costs and the State share is the remaining 36%.
