Dear Mr. Nitschke:

We are in receipt of the North Dakota Public Service Commission's ("Commission") March 6, 2017, correspondence regarding potential outstanding issues in the above-referenced case. Enclosed is a hard copy and an electronic copy of Hess North Dakota Export Logistics LLC's ("Hess") Stormwater Pollution Plan, including the Authorization to Discharge Under the North Dakota Pollutant Discharge Elimination System which addresses the only outstanding issue referenced in the March 6, 2017 correspondence.

Williams County does not require a conditional use permit for pipeline projects regulated by the Commission. Hess filed documentation from Williams County on July 18, 2016, that no conditional use permit was needed for this project. That documentation is contained at Docket #18 for this case. Hess' Tree and Shrub Mitigation plan is contained at Docket #17 for this case. It is my understanding that all reclamation for the project was completed in November of 2016. Please advise what reclamation work, if any, the Commission believes is still required for the project. Thank you.
