

II.

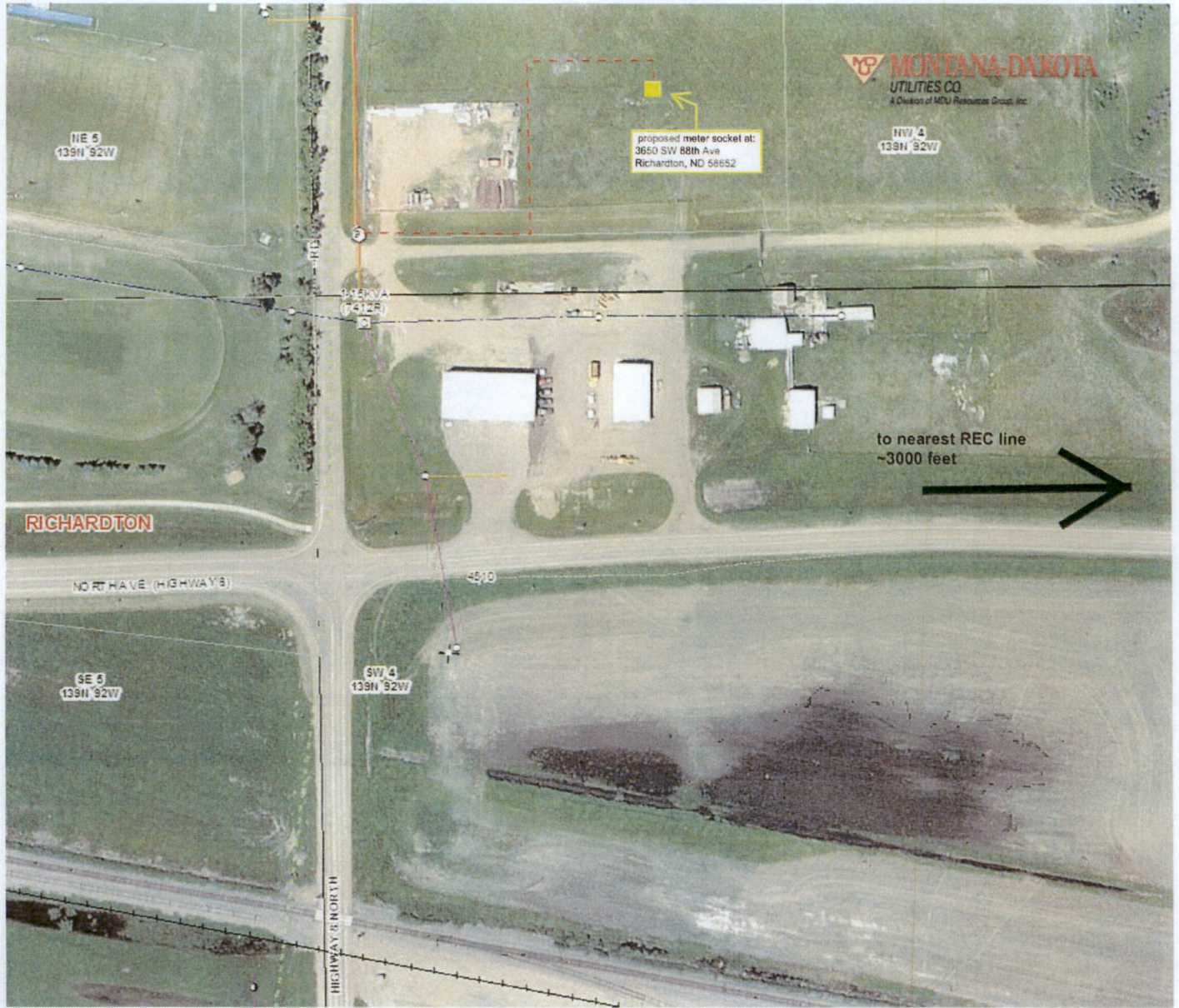
That all the allegations of the Application herein are true and correct.
