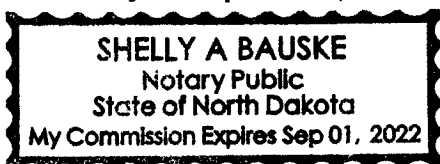

ORDER GRANTING REQUEST  
TO DISCONTINUE BUSINESS

Farmers Elevator Company of Cooperstown operates a licensed public grain warehouse at Cooperstown, North Dakota, under license number 462 issued by the Public Service Commission under the provisions of North Dakota Century Code Chapter 60-02. The Commission received a request to discontinue business for this facility.

Order
