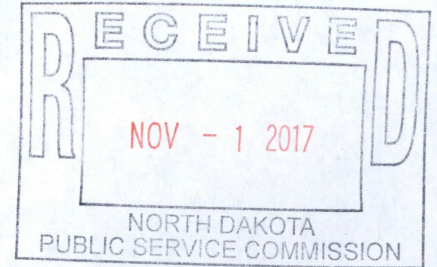

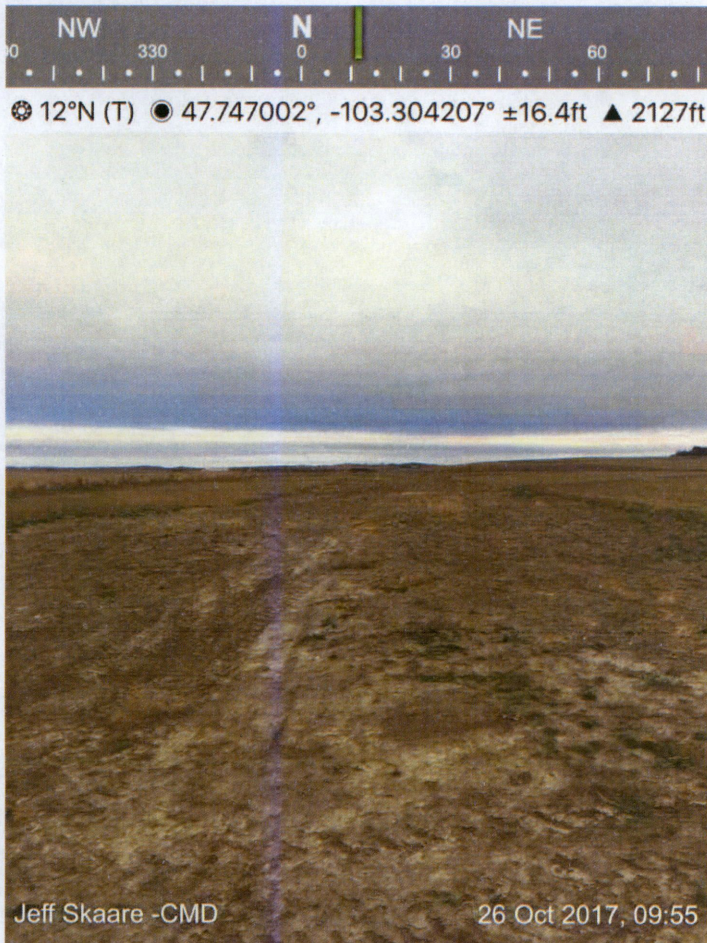

Response to Items Identified in the Wenck As-Built Inspection Report

Item 1 – Soil subsidence (Photo 4, GPS Point 522)

This area has been re-graded and topsoil added to fill in the subsidence as shown in the photo below. Work was conducted approximately 8/2017. Vegetative growth is sparse due to drought conditions.



Item 2 – Canada Thistle (Photo 7, GPS Point 524)

Canada Thistle in this area was mowed approximately 7/2017 and subsequently sprayed by McKenzie County (due to primarily existing in the County Road Easement) at an unknown time following mowing. This site will require additional treatments, and these treatments are planned for Spring 2018.



General Summary of Planned Future Restoration Activities

Due to ongoing drought conditions and poor vegetative growth of desired plant species over much of the project footprint, Caliber Midstream has contracted a third-party restoration and seeding company to provide additional drill seeding, disking, fertilization, mulch, and weed treatments over the majority of the right-of-way. These activities will commence in the Spring of 2018.
