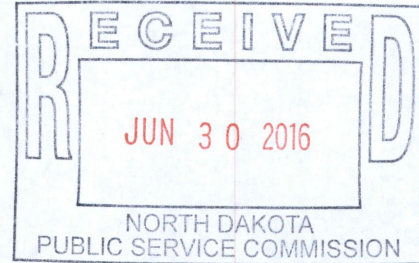



Langdon Wind consists of 106 GE 1.5 SLE wind turbines and has been in production since December 2007. Langdon Wind contributes approximately 159 MW of renewable energy to the power grid. The project is not expected to retire in the next ten years—two Power Purchase Agreements are in place through the end of 2032 and 2033.


Section K: Environmental Information

 - b. Adaptive Management Plans were developed for both construction activities and post-construction operations. Appropriate responses for various types of avian sightings are detailed within.
 - c. Spill Prevention Control and Countermeasure Plans specify processes for dealing with all chemical, hazardous, and oil spills that may occur on the property.


