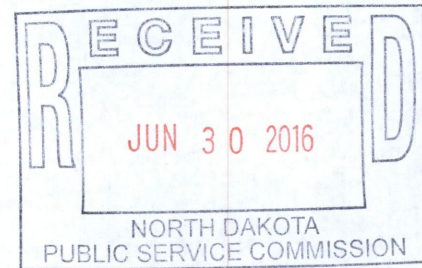



Oliver Wind consists of 22 Siemens Mk II wind turbines and has been in production since December 2006. Oliver Wind contributes approximately 50.6 MW of renewable energy to the power grid. The project is not expected to retire in the next ten years—a Power Purchase Agreement is in place with Minnesota Power through the end of 2031.


Section K: Environmental Information

 - b. An Adaptive Management Plan was developed for both construction activities and post-construction operations. Appropriate responses for various types of avian sightings are detailed within.
 - c. Spill Prevention Control and Countermeasure Plan specifies processes for dealing with all chemical, hazardous, and oil spills that may occur on the property.


