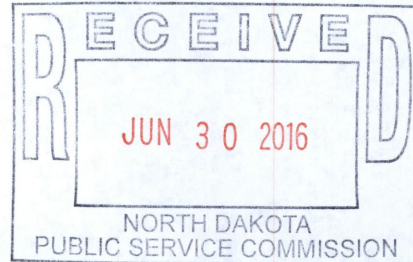



Wilton Wind II consists of 33 GE 1.5 SLE wind turbines and has been in production since November 2009. Wilton Wind II contributes approximately 49.5 MW of renewable energy to the power grid. The project is not expected to retire in the next ten years—a Power Purchase Agreement is in place with Basin Electric Power Cooperative through the end of 2034.


Section K: Environmental Information

 - a. A comprehensive Wildlife Response and Reporting Manual is in place to record any avian fatalities and/or injuries that are found within the wind plant boundaries.
 - b. An Adaptive Management Plan was developed for both construction activities and post-construction operations. Appropriate responses for various types of avian sightings are detailed within.
 - c. Spill Prevention Control and Countermeasure Plan specifies processes for dealing with all chemical, hazardous, and oil spills that may occur on the property.


