**RE:** Flasher Farmers Union Grain & Oil  
License Suspension

The grain warehouse bond for Flasher Farmers Union Grain & Oil is scheduled to expire on September 6, 2016. North Dakota Century Code section 60-02-09.1 requires that unless the warehouseman files a new bond at least thirty days before liability ceases, the Commission, without hearing, shall immediately suspend the warehouseman's license and the suspension may not be removed until a new bond has been filed and approved by the Commission. As of August 5, 2016, no replacement bond was filed with the Commission.

Attached are a motion and order suspending the grain warehouse license of Flasher Farmers Union Grain & Oil, effective August 6, 2016. The order sets forth compliances for the licensee. Flasher Farmers Union Grain & Oil has until September 6, 2016, to procure and file an adequate bond or submit a written request for hearing. If a bond is not filed by September 6, 2016, the suspension will remain in place and the Commission will start the license revocation process.
