ORDER ON CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE & NECESSITY

November 2, 2016

On **September 1, 2016**, Otter Tail Power Company, an electric public utility, filed an application under Chapter 49-03, N.D.C.C. to extend service to Cando Farmers Grain at a location in Towner County, North Dakota.

On **September 21, 2016**, the Commission issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing in this proceeding. The Notice provided if no objections were received by **October 17, 2016**, the application would be granted as requested.

On **October 3, 2016**, Northern Plains Electric Power Cooperative requested an extension to the response date.

On **October 5, 2016**, the Commission granted an extension for response from **October 17, 2016 to October 26, 2016**. No objections have been received.

Otter Tail Power Company is issued Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, Certificate Number 5894, authorizing the provision of electric distribution service to Cando Farmers Grain at a point located in:
