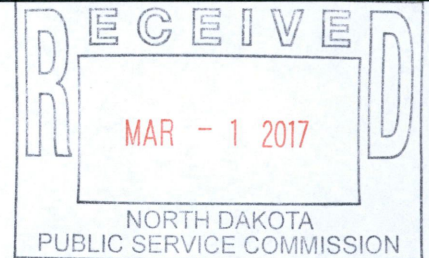

The North Dakota Geological Survey appreciates the notification and opportunity to review and provide comment on the proposed pipeline conversion project in McKenzie Co. The route of the existing crude oil gathering pipeline, which is proposed for conversion, was reviewed on February 10, 2017.

Regarding the proposed pipeline conversion project, it should be noted that landslides have been mapped in the vicinity of the existing pipeline route and within the 0.5 mile analysis area (Murphy, 2004). Even though it appears that there have not been any mapped landslides along the actual pipeline route, an enhanced level of monitoring and periodic inspection of this line may be warranted.


