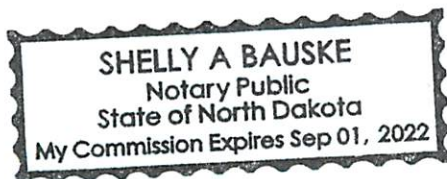

NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR COMMENT

January 4, 2017

On December 18, 2013, the Commission designated Total Call Mobile, Inc. (Total Call) as an eligible telecommunications carrier (ETC) for the purpose of receiving federal universal service support for low-income consumers in all study areas in North Dakota, Case No. PU-12-820.

On December 19, 2016, the Commission received Total Call's notice or intention to relinquish the ETC designation due to changes in the wireless industry and proposed modifications to the Federal Communications Commission's Lifeline program.

Under 47 U.S.C. section 214(e)(4) and 47 C.F.R. section 54.205, the Commission shall permit a carrier to relinquish its ETC designation for an area served by more than one eligible telecommunications carrier. Prior to permitting a telecommunications carrier designated as an eligible telecommunications carrier to cease providing universal service in an area served by more than one eligible telecommunications carrier, the state commission shall require the remaining eligible telecommunications carrier or carriers to ensure that all customers served by the relinquishing carrier will continue to be served, and shall require sufficient notice to permit the purchase or construction of adequate facilities by any remaining eligible telecommunications carrier. The state commission shall establish a time, not to exceed one year after the state commission approves such relinquishment under this section, within which such purchase or construction shall be completed. Total Call states that it has no subscribers in North Dakota.

The Commission will receive written comments in this proceeding until close of business on February 17, 2017.
