Dear Mr. Nitschke:

In accordance with North Dakota Century Code Section 49-22-03(3), this letter is provided to notify the North Dakota Public Service Commission (“Commission”) that Hiland Crude, LLC (“Hiland”) intends to modify the New Town Expansion Project (“Pipeline”) by constructing two pump station facilities within the previously designated corridor in Mountrail County, North Dakota. The Commission issued a Certificate of Corridor Compatibility and Route Permit for the Pipeline in Case No. PU-15-416.

The modifications to the Pipeline will allow for an increase in the throughput of the existing Pipeline and provide other operational benefits. Drawings depicting the modifications and locations of the pump station facilities are attached to the Certification submitted herewith.

Work associated with the Edgewater Pump Station will include relocating and installing an existing 2,000 HP pump, along with appurtenant facilities and miscellaneous piping. Work associated with the North Antelope Pump Station will include installing a new injection pump, along with appurtenant facilities and miscellaneous piping. All construction activities associated with the Edgewater Pump Station and the North Antelope Pump Station will be within the 250-foot-wide designated corridor for the Pipeline.

In accordance with N.D.C.C. § 49-22-03(3)(a), Hiland states as follows:


- (1) The construction activities for the two pump station facilities are of the same type as the existing transmission facility and will be conducted wholly within the existing designated corridor for the Pipeline.
- (2) An environmental analysis, conducted for Hiland in connection with the original Consolidated Application submitted to the Commission for the Pipeline, evaluated the designated corridor for Exclusion and Avoidance Areas as set forth in N.D. Admin. Code § 69-06-08-02. This information has again been reviewed for the

installation of the pump station facilities. The addition of the pump station facilities will not affect any known Exclusion or Avoidance Areas.

- (3) The installation of the pump station facilities will increase the throughput of the existing Pipeline and provide other operational benefits to the Pipeline.
- (4) The attached Certification provides the information required by N.D.C.C. § 49-22-03(3)(a)(4). As set forth in the Certification, Hiland will comply with all applicable conditions and protections in siting laws and rules and Commission orders previously issued for the Pipeline.

Hiland requests the Commission acknowledge receipt of the attached Certification and appreciates the time and attention provided to this matter by the Commission and staff. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact Hiland.

William E. Wolf, being first duly sworn upon oath, states and alleges as follows:

1. I am Assistant General Counsel for Kinder Morgan, Inc., am familiar with the New Town Expansion Project (“Pipeline”) that is the subject of Case No. PU-15-416, am familiar with the planned facility construction activities associated with the Pipeline that is the subject of this Certification, and have the authority to bind Hiland Crude, LLC (“Hiland”) with respect to the certifications made herein.

2. I provide this Certification in support of Hiland’s plans to construct facilities within the corridor designated by the North Dakota Public Service Commission (“Commission”) for the Pipeline pursuant to North Dakota Century Code (“N.D.C.C.”) § 49-22-03(3)(a).

3. On June 26, 2015, Hiland filed with the Commission a Consolidated Application for a Certificate of Corridor Compatibility and Route Permit (“Consolidated Application”) to authorize the conversion of the Pipeline located in Mountrail County, North Dakota from a gathering pipeline to a transmission system, and installation of interconnect facilities to a third party storage facility.

4. On January 20, 2016, the Commission entered its Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order (“Order”) issuing Corridor Certificate Number 178 and Route Permit Number 190 for the Pipeline to Hiland Crude.

5. In accordance with N.D.C.C. § 49-22-03(3)(a)(3)(d), Hiland intends to construct two pump station facilities within the previously designated corridor for the Pipeline, which will allow for an increase in the throughput of the existing Pipeline and provide other operational benefits to the Pipeline and associated pipelines. The pump station facilities are of the same type of facility as the existing Pipeline, i.e., a transmission facility as defined in N.D.C.C. § 49-22-03(12).

6. The pump stations will further enhance operational efficiency of the Pipeline, and will allow Hiland to maximize use of the existing Pipeline, allowing Hiland to accept additional production into the Pipeline from nearby wells.

7. As noted in the Commission Order, the Pipeline was tested to a maximum operating pressure of 1,440 pounds per square inch gauge. Even with the addition of the two pump station facilities, the Pipeline will operate at or below the maximum operating pressure allowed for the Pipeline.

8. The Edgewater Pump Station will be located in the SW/4NE/4 of Section 31, Township 154 North, Range 93 West, Mountrail County, North Dakota. Work associated with the Edgewater Pump Station will include relocating and installing an existing 2,000 HP pump, along with appurtenant facilities and miscellaneous piping.

9. The North Antelope Pump Station will be located in the NE/4NE/4 of Section 1, Township 154 North, Range 94 West, Mountrail County, North Dakota. Work associated with


the North Antelope Pump Station will include installing a new injection pump, along with appurtenant facilities and miscellaneous piping.

10. All construction activities associated with the Edgewater Pump Station and the North Antelope Pump Station will be within the 250-foot-wide designated corridor for the Pipeline. Maps depicting the designated corridor and route for the Pipeline, the planned location of the North Antelope Pump Station, and the planned location of the Edgewater Pump Station are attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.

11. In conjunction with the Consolidated Application submitted to the Commission for the Pipeline, Keitu Engineers & Consultants, Inc. conducted the necessary field studies to confirm the presence or absence of exclusion and avoidance areas within the designated corridor. The exclusion area and avoidance area information has been reviewed, and the construction activities for the Edgewater Pump Station and the North Antelope Pump Station will not affect any known exclusion or avoidance areas.


12. Hiland will comply with all applicable conditions and protections in siting laws and rules and Commission orders previously issued for any part of the facility.
