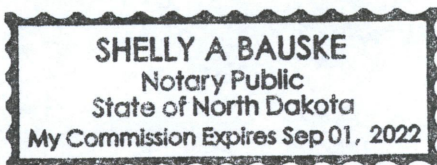


NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

January 18, 2017

On December 30, 2016, Otter Tail Power Company (Otter Tail) filed a request for approval of its 2017 Renewable Resource Cost Recovery Adjustment Factor for recovering costs associated with its electric generation wind farms, effective April 1, 2017. The proposed change would decrease the monthly bill by \$0.49 cents for the average residential customers using 1,000 kWh.

The issue to be considered is whether the proposed cost recovery is fair and reasonable.


Comments and requests for a hearing must be received by **March 1, 2017**. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. If deemed appropriate, the commission can determine these matters without a hearing.
